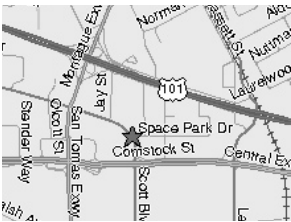
Film: **Caught in Between: What to call home in times of war**
